Auckland

Day 1: Arrive Auckland

Airport transfer and hotel check-in, then you're free to see Auckland for yourself. An evening welcome drink followed by dinner with your Tour Director.

Day 2: Auckland - Rotorua

Day 3: Rotorua

Watch the Agrodome Sheep Show then the afternoon is yours. Our option tonight is 🌿 The Realm of Tāne, a journey through Maori mythology and our story of creation. **B**

Day 4: Rotorua - Wellington

Heading south, you'll view the Huka Falls. Visit Taupo. Drive along the shores of New Zealand's biggest lake, through the alpine scenery of Mt. Ruapehu. Tongariro National Park and the dairy farms of Manawatu. Then it's along the Kapiti Coast to Wellington for a City Sights tour.

Hotel: Mercure Willis Street, Wellington. **B D**

Day 5: Wellington - Picton

A morning of 'Free Time' in Wellington, then you visit 🌿 Te Papa, the Museum of New Zealand. Photos at Parliament House. Then cruise on Queen Charlotte Sound. Later you'll travel to the seaside village of Picton for an orientation tour.

Day 6: Picton - Christchurch

En route to Christchurch, get up close and personal with some New Zealand fur seals at Ohau Point, watch whales at Kaikoura, (optional scenic Whale Watching flight), travel along the rugged Pacific Ocean coast, across the Canterbury Plains to Christchurch.

Day 7: Mt. Cook

After a morning at leisure travel over the patchwork countryside of the Canterbury Plains, where the spectacular sightseeing begins. Lake Tekapo and Lake Pukaki are first up. Next you'll visit the Church of the Good Shepherd before soaking up the sensational alpine landscape of Mt. Cook National Park (optional scenic flight).

Day 8: Dunedin

Our day starts along the Waitaki River with the Waitaki Hydro Power Scheme and Benmore Dam. Travel through Oamaru with its famous white limestone buildings to Dunedin, where you tour the city. Then you've got the afternoon to yourself - take a Wildlife Cruise, visit the Cadbury Chocolate Factory or ride the historic Taieri Gorge Railway.

Hotel: Kingsgate Hotel, Dunedin. **B D**

Day 9: Dunedin - Te Anau

After a morning of time to yourself, during which you might like to tour New Zealand's Larnach Castle, head off across South Otago's fertile, sheep-filled farming land en route to Te Anau, on the shores of the largest lake in the South Island. Tonight you may choose to travel by boat to the Te Anau Glow Worm Caves.

Day 10: Milford Sound

You'll be awe-struck by great sights from Fiordland National Park to Milford Sound, where you will cruise on the waters of this natural wonder. Along the way to Queenstown, see the Mirror Lake, Cleddau Valley, the Chasm, Mitre Peak, Bowen Falls, travel along the Devil's Staircase and the shores of Lake Wakatipu. At Queenstown you'll have an orientation tour on arrival and enjoy dinner with views over Lake Wakatipu and the Remarkables.

Hotel: Mercure Queenstown Resort, Queenstown, 2 nights. **B D**

Day 11: Queenstown 'Free Time'

Explore exciting Queenstown your way, all day - from wine and garden tours to jet boat rides and white water rafting. A delicious buffet at the Skyline Restaurant on Bob's Peak is your spectacular dining option. Access is via the steepest Gondola in the Southern Hemisphere. 🌿 Optional Kiwi Haka Maori Show post-dinner. **B**

Day 12: Fox Glacier

First stop, Arrowtown, on the Arrow River. Second stop Cromwell and its sensational stone fruit. Then it's a trio of lakes - Lake Dunstan, Lake Hawea, Lake Wanaka. Through the Haast Pass, you view Thunder Creek Falls and enjoy a rainforest walk. Final stop, majestic Fox Glacier - a rare, still advancing glacier. Take the opportunity for an optional scenic flight over the glacier.

Hotel: Heartland Hotel Fox Glacier, Fox Glacier. **B D**

Day 13: Christchurch

Visit Hokitika, home of the native greenstone (jade), for a factory visit and jewellery demonstration first up. Travel through Greymouth, the largest town on the West Coast, before heading back to Christchurch.

Day 14: Depart Christchurch

After breakfast you are transferred to Christchurch Airport for your onward flight. **B**
